Responding to Military Children with Exceptional Needs™ is a professional development institute, designed for youth-serving professionals, that addresses the challenges military-connected children with exceptional needs may face as they transition from school to school.

Course Format

This course includes 12 clock hours of face-to-face instruction (up to 50 people per session) and group work time, exclusive of breaks and lunch. This course is offered over two consecutive days.

Credit Options: Course participants are eligible for Continuing Education opportunities for completing this twelve clock hour course.
